



WHY DO AN INTERNSHIP?

Have you been gripped by the beauty, truth, and relevance of Jesus? Are you eager to invest in the mission of knowing Jesus and making Jesus known? Are you keen to grow and mature in your faith?

If any of these are true for you, here are three good reasons to sign up for a City on a Hill internship:

- 1. Internships are a fantastic opportunity to step up and into what God has for you as one of his beloved children.
- 2. Internships enable you to discover and use the gifts God has given you to serve others for His glory.
- 3. Internships provide a deeper insight into what church is all about and what it takes to build a growing, gospel-fuelled movement.



WHAT DOES IT INVOLVE?

A City on a Hill Internship is a voluntary, guided, practical ministry experience. It involves a commitment of 16 hours per week, from the beginning of March to the end of November.

Interns are connected to one of our church's ministry areas and assigned a supervisor to guide and encourage them in undertaking real ministry tasks. Interns serve in all sorts of areas – kids ministry, youth group, gospel communities, connections, music, communications, media, administration and training.

In addition, interns help our Sunday services happen and participate in a regular face to face training session with staff. For those who have not yet completed the "Greenhouse" discipleship development program, we require that you enrol for the next year as part of the internship.

As you serve alongside City on a Hill staff and engage with the training, the Lord will stretch you and grow you in your knowledge, love and service of Him.





WHO IS IT FOR?

Our internships are for anyone who loves Jesus and wants to see His name honoured and His kingdom grow.

We are not looking for perfect people, just people who have been gripped by the love of Christ. We are not only looking for people who have been Christians for many years, just people who are keen to grow and learn in knowing Jesus and making him known. We are not looking for people of any particular age, just people who are willing to serve.

In short, we are looking for faithful, available and teachable people.
